Collectively, the private lands targeted by this project represent parts of agricultural areas of southeastern Australia, and the least disturbed Mallee ecosystem in Australia.

The largely agricultural landscape supports significant areas of high value remnants, providing ecological linkages to aid species dispersal and support climate change adaptation. These landscapes are therefore vital to the protection of over 200 native species they support (including EPBC and/ or FFG listed bush-stone curlew, regent parrot, inland carpet python, lined earless dragon and Buloke Woodland communities) and the broader ecosystem services they provide.

Weed, rabbit and fox populations pose large threats to the landscape in the Mallee, impacting on native flora and fauna, therefore it is critical management practice to control these threats. All proposed weed and rabbit areas identified will need to be within remnant vegetation to be eligible to apply. Environmental weeds such as WONS (Weeds of National Significance) prickly pear, wheel cactus, Hudson pear, African boxthorn and bridal creeper are being targeted. Refer to fox, rabbit and weed target areas (Appendix 1) to be eligible to apply for fox, rabbit and weed control.

The Mallee Catchment Management Authority (CMA), with support from the Victorian Government, has committed to providing funding over three years (2018-19 to 2020-21) for the Biodiversity Response Planning Program.

The funding will be used to establish agreements between Mallee CMA and private land owners to deliver weed, rabbit and fox control activities in the project target area shown in Appendix 1.

Activities that will be carried out within the project area are listed below;

Rabbit Control

Any rabbit control outlined in this application by the landholder will be coordinated and undertaken by a Mallee CMA contractor in agreement with the landholder. All rabbit control will need to be undertaken within the defined project area (Appendix 1) and within remnant vegetation.

Weed Control

Approved private landholders will receive a grant for any weed control work, upfront, and it is the landholder's responsibility to undertake the works. All weed control will need to be undertaken within the defined project area (Appendix 1) and within remnant vegetation. Data will need to be submitted to the Mallee CMA Project Officer after completing the weed control works. Data includes; GPS coordinates of treated weeds, travel logs and identification of treated weed at each GPS location. The landholder will be required to take photos, before the works, during the works and on completion of the works and submit the photos to the Mallee CMA Project Officer.
