## Threatened Mallee Birds Project



*The Desert Heathlands of north-western Victoria and eastern South Australia are vital for the future of many threatened Mallee bird species. However, we currently know almost nothing about the locations of Threatened Mallee Birds in these environments.*



### Where will we go:

Remote parts of Wyperfeld National Park (Vic), Big Desert Wilderness (Vic) and Ngarkat (SA)

### What will we do:

Survey for Threatened Mallee Birds in areas with little survey history

### What is required:

- Experience camping/working in remote places
- High level of physical fitness (walking 15 km daily)
- Experience in bird surveys/bird ID

### What are the benefits:

- Contribute to bird conservation
- See beautiful environments
- See rare and threatened birds
- Meals and transport provided
